
The provision of cycle hubs with covered areas, showers and lockers, electric car charging points, car club membership options and a Greater Manchester wide car share scheme all provide opportunities for our community to travel in a cost effective and sustainable way.

MediaCityUK originally aspired to encourage 45% + of residents and employees to use transport methods other than single occupancy car usage. Surveys show, however, that 52% of people are currently walking, cycling and using taxis and this figure rises to over 60% if initiatives such as car sharing are taken into account.
